## Pathway to Policy Change—Identifying Key Indicators to Monitor Policy Process

The Pathway approach allows organizations to identify the different steps involved in implementing a policy intervention so they can identify specific interventions/actions and the process and output indicators that would be used to monitor the policy process. The highlighted boxes in the example presented below show points where an organization may wish to monitor the process.

The Pathway may take any route or shape, and may include arrows in many different directions. The example below is only an illustration. Teams should consider their own particular context and policy intervention in crafting the Pathway to Policy Change.
