

Policy Monitoring Logic Model

The logic model captures the information needed to monitor and evaluate the policy process and, ultimately, the success of policy implementation. The policy development and implementation process will feed into the logic model's process and output indicators. The importance of evaluating policy implementation is highlighted by indicators related to outcome and desired impact, and evaluation questions.
